

August 1st, 2024 Supervisors Minutes

Chairman Clapper called the August 1, 2024 Supervisors meeting to order.

The following members were present: Don Clapper, Greg Thomas.

The minutes from the July 18th meeting were approved as written.

The Treasurers report was distributed to each Supervisor for review.

Chairman Clapper opened with Privilege of the floor – No Comment

A request was received from St. Thomas Township Board of Supervisors requesting Fire Police assistance for a Make-A-Wish Truck Convoy Non-Emergency event on August 17, 2024, 8:00 am - 5:00 pm. On a Thomas/Clapper motion carried unanimously, the Supervisors approved the request.

Chairman Clapper gave an update on the MS4 progress. He discussed that we received a list of BMP's from Dewberry that we have to get the designs for and that he has Greg Lebo working on that.

Chambersburg Waste Paper (CWP) now has their new transfer station open and had a discussion with Chairman Clapper about the possibility of having Bulk day at their facility. Mr. Adams sent a proposal for the two day event (a copy was distributed to each Supervisor). They are offering to man the entire event charging the Township \$135/ton for trash. We will supply one or two people to check residency. They will split the metal proceeds with the Township. We are looking at having the event on September 27 & 28. Since it will be a change in venue we will be sending out postcards. Chairman Clapper made a motion that we sign the agreement with CWP and get the promotional information out. The motion was seconded by Thomas and was carried unanimously.

On a Thomas/Clapper motion carried unanimously, the Supervisors approved the paying of the bills.
